The heart of the Australian wine industry, South Australia's rich wine heritage dates back to 1836. The Mediterranean climate with warm/hot summers and cold, wet winters produces full-flavoured, fruit-driven Chardonnay with great structure and persistence of flavour.

COLOUR

Pale straw with a vibrant green hue.

BOUQUET

Citrus and white stone fruits with melon overtones.

PALATE

White peach, citrus and melon characters with well-balanced, lively acidity, and a long crisp, clean finish.

WINEMAKING TECHNIQUES

Grapes are picked on both colour and flavour development. Fruit is machine harvested in the cool of the night. Cold settling and juice clarification prior to fermentation are used to enhance fruit purity. Cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks with neutral yeast ensures optimum development of varietal characters. Following maturation the wine is blended and prepared for bottling.
