2014 Limited Release Shiraz It doesn't roll, it creeps. It's like a lava flow of blackberried flavour. Its bones are fortified with tannin, its inky depths layered with sweet, cedary oak. It needs time to all come together, but it will mature (well) over decades. Cellar to 2038.

2014 Classic McLaren Vale Shiraz Firm and brooding with black-berried fruit stuffed into every corner. If you're looking for a substantial red, this would be a top choice. It tastes of blackberry, cloves, redcurrant and must, the latter character evident in the floral note to the bouquet too. **Terrific value.** Cellar to 2034.

2014 Estate Blewitt Springs Cabernet Sauvignon Thick-flavoured, but lively. Smoked cedar wood, concentrated plum, blackcurrant, bay leaves, fresh boysenberry. An array of flavours to admire. The texture too is silken; the tannin exquisitely well integrated. Serious intensity swings effortlessly through a beautifully formed palate. Cellar to 2032.

2014 Estate Blewitt Springs Shiraz It pours on the flavour but contingencies of tannin keep everything firmly in place. Red and black berries, a sweet redcurrant-like note, not a lot of spice or savoury input, but clovery oak fills the void. **Quality is undeniable.** Cellar to 2030.

2014 Estate Blewitt Springs Grenache Deep and rugged. Unusual in the varietal context. Blackberry, dry licorice, ironstone, undergrowth and malt. Its weighty flavours creep slowly and deliberately through the palate. Along the way, more than a little gravitas is established. Cellar to 2024.
