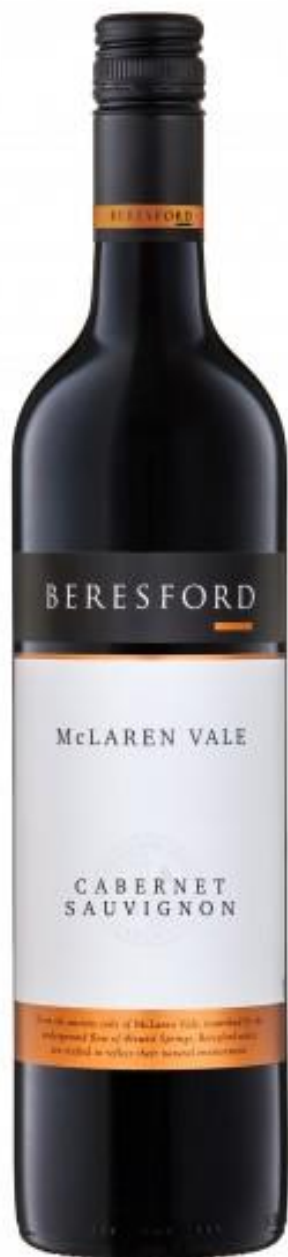

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

VINTAGE	2016
REGION	Blewitt Springs, McLaren Vale The Beresford Estate Vineyard was first planted in the 1960's and located at the height of one of McLaren Vale's most elevated sites in the cool Blewitt Springs sub-region, sitting 130 meters above sea level.
COLOUR	Dark plum colour
BOUQUET	Lifted, fresh characteristics of blackcurrant and violets. Vanilla, primary raspberry and plum fruits, cherry with an underlying hint of spice.
PALATE	Bright, young and vibrant medium bodied palate, showing red berry flavours, supported by hints of cigar box and cedar in the background. A juicy mid palate presenting great structure, with a balanced acidity.
WINEMAKING	Sourced from the Beresford Estate Vineyard in the cool sub-region of Blewitt Springs, the grapes were harvested on both colour and flavour development then crushed and fermented for 7-10 days at approximately 24 degrees. Small open top fermenters are used with hand pumping over and rack and returns to ensure optimum extraction of flavor, tannins and colour is achieved. The ferment is then softly pressed using an airbag press, producing a balanced style of wine. Further complexity is developed with 20% of the blend receiving 14 months maturation in seasoned American oak hogsheads and 10% in new French oak. The balance of the blend is matured in 2 and 3-year-old French oak hogsheads.
