Hand Picked from 60-year-old Grenache Bush Grown Vines at the Beresford Estate Vineyard in Blewitt Springs. The must was chilled for less than ${\bf 1}$ hour on the Grenache grape skins to extract the lovely subtle pink colour pigments. Bottled young to capture the fresh red fruits of our old Grenache bush vine. A light, crisp and delicate style, suited to hot days, served ice cold.
